COMPUTER CLEAN UP

At least once a year, more often if your tower sits on the floor where the fan is likely to pull in more dust, your computer needs to be cleaned of all the dust sucked in by the computer fan.

Shut down the computer. Unplug your tower's power cord. Remove the CPU (tower) cover. Place hands on the frame to discharge static electricity from yourself.

Using a can of compressed air, blow out those dust bunnies from the cards, and in the fan blades, etc.

Put the cover back on, plug it in and you're ready to go.

While you've got the compressed air, it's a good time to blow the dust and cookie crumbs from the keyboard as well.

Caution: It is not recommended to open the case of a Laptop Computer.
