Rockwell HCA Internal Modems

If you're being kicked off AOL(dialup) a lot (may also work with other ISPs) and you have a Rockwell HCA 56K modem, try this:

Go to Control Panel, doubleclick Modem, click Properties, select the Connection tab and ADvanced. Change the selection for flow control to software rather than hardware. Click OK

If you're still getting kicked off leave the software selection and Try this modem string in your SETUP on the AOL Welcome page. Click SETUP, Devices, Edit Modem, your modem should be highlighted, click Edit Command.

Write down the string(top line) as it is now so if my suggestion doesn't work you can change it back. Yours is probably this right now AT&F&C1&DOS95=1^M

Change that to read: AT&F&C1DOS95=1+MS=V34^M thats a 'one' next to the C and it is a 'zero' after D

Now click APPLY and OK and restart your computer.

If you're still getting kicked off repeatedly, try this: Disable your anti-virus program, and sign on, to see if it stops the kick offs.
