MONITOR CARE

Have you ever noticed how often we touch computer screens? Sometimes we're pointing something out to a friend, family member, or colleague, and sometimes we are adjusting the position of the monitor on the desk. In any case, this touching makes cleaning a computer monitor more of a regular activity than, say, cleaning a television screen.

What should you use to clean your monitor's screen?

First, follow the manufacturer's instructions for cleaning, particularly if you suspect your display is made from unusual materials. However, in most cases a slightly damp soft cotton cloth should work fine. Never spray anything onto the monitor screen as it may run down the front of your monitor screen and find its way into the monitor casing.
