ANTIVIRUS PROGRAM RESCUE DISK

Anti-Virus Program Rescue disk is a utility that creates a bootable floppy disk or flash drive that you can use to start your computer and scan it for viruses if a virus keeps you from starting it normally.

Creating a rescue disk for McAfee users is easy.

- 1. Insert a new floppy into drive A: or plug in a flash drive.
- 2. Right click on the McAfee icon in the system tray
- 3. Select VirusScan
- 4. Select Create Rescue Disk

note: after the Rescue disk (or flash drive) is created it should be made write protected and just like the virus protection itself should be updated regularly.

Rescue disks for Norton's antivirus

Click Norton's Antivirus or System Works and select Create Rescue Disks
If the option is not on your Start Menu list, then open the Norton's program, click HELP and Index.
Type in Rescue Disk and follow directions.

Rescue Disks must be updated regularly.
