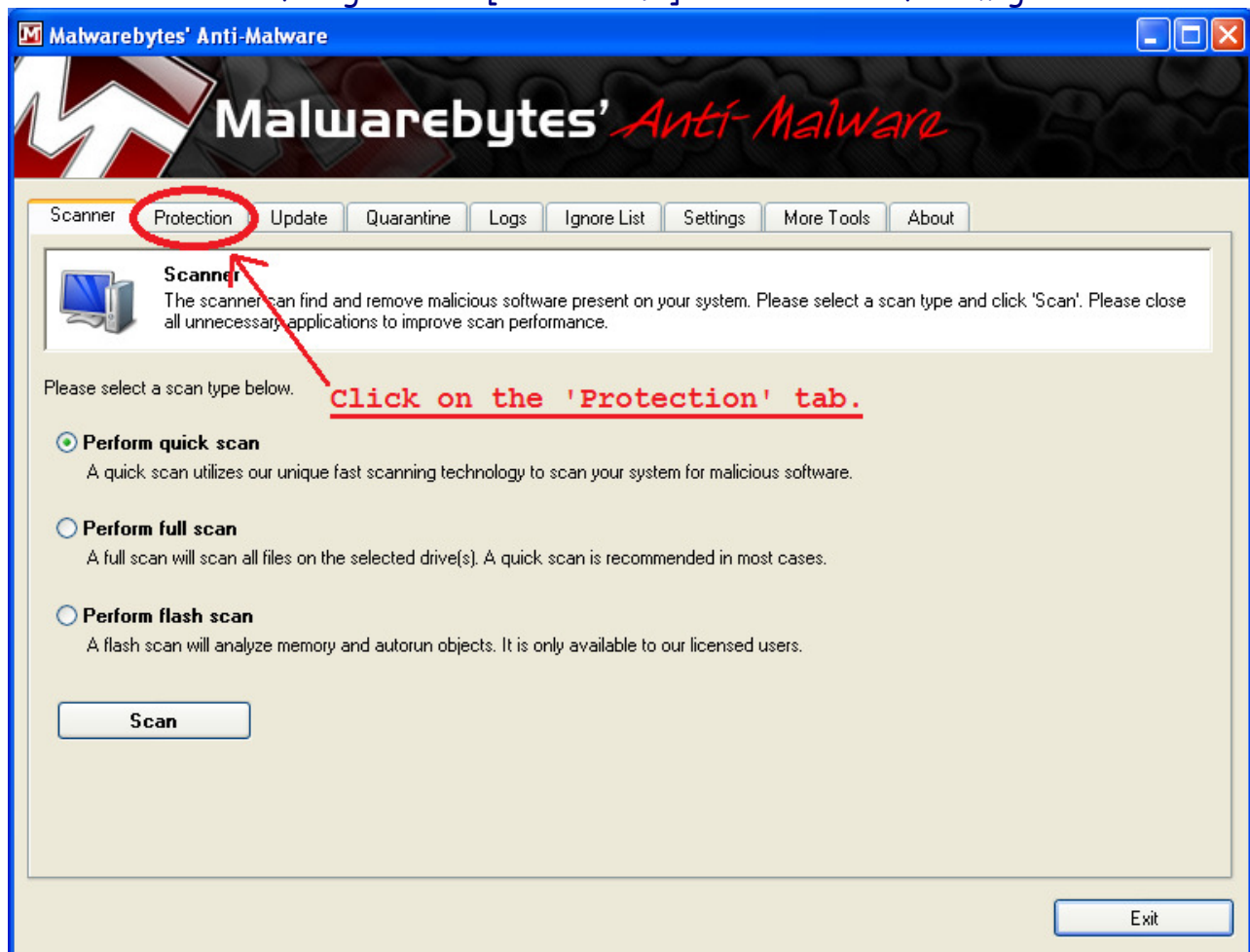


Malwarebytes Paid Version Setup

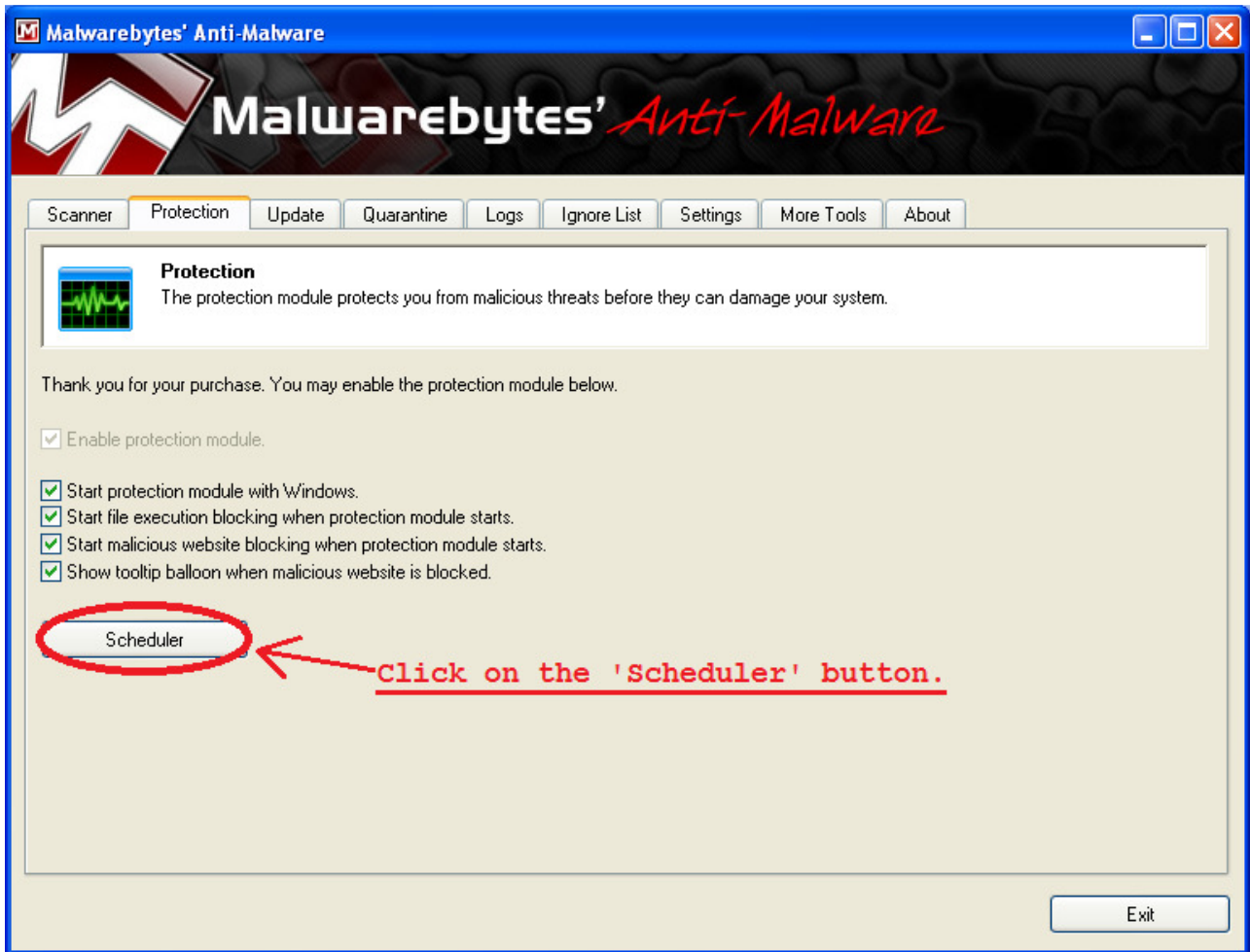
Amazingly when you purchase Malwarebytes to automatically update and run in the background to keep baddies out, the scheduler is NOT set by default. You need to know where it is to set it. It is NOT in Settings, as one would expect. Below is Malwarebytes tutorial on setting the Scheduler

Version 1.45 of Malwarebytes' Anti-Malware introduced a new scheduler (which is also in version 1.46). This is intended on being a quick guide covering only the basics. This tutorial will be updated/replaced by a later tutorial that covers more of the advanced options as well.

Scheduler

Type | Starting on | Frequency | Repeating every

The 'Scan' tab is for scheduling automatic scans.

The 'Frequency' dropdown is for selecting how often to run the scheduled scan.

Scan Update

Frequency: Daily Recover if missed by: 0 hour(s)
Starting on: 3/30/2010 11:15 PM Repeating every: 1 day(s)
Type: Quick scan

Wake computer from sleep to perform task.
 Perform scheduled scan silently from system account.
 Terminate program when scan completes successfully.
 Remove and quarantine all threats automatically.
 Save log file regardless of user settings.
 Restart the computer if required for threat removal.

The "Starting on" dropdown is for setting the day and time that the first scan of this schedule should run.

The 'Add' button adds the scheduled scan to the list.
