

Wireless Roku XD Streams Netflix

I've been trying to get a setup to easily download Netflix, Amazon and other movies for a long time. This week my daughter comes to visit and says we're getting your Christmas present today. We went to Radio Shack and she purchased 2 Roku XD digital players (~ \$50 each). When we got home she connected one to the TV in our computer room and the other to the TV in our Living Room. The video cables came with the box.

I got on the computer and went to Roku.com, registered the program, joined Netflix (\$9.99/mo), loaded the que with about a dozen movies and viola!!!! On the Roku TV screen clicked Netflix and behold there on the screen was the list of Netflix movies ready for viewing. The entire process within 2 hours, but that was because it's not easy to get to the back of our TVs.

Great little box!!! The links above give all the info you need to connect and install and view movies very inexpensively.

There are many download sites listed on the Roku when you bring it up, but be careful to check if it's the type of movie downloads you want to watch. Also check if that download site is Free or for pay. For instance, Amazon has movies for download, but you must first register with Amazon and then pay for each movie you download. Netflix you pay the \$9.99 and download all the movies you have time to watch that month.
