

DOWNLOADING PROGRAMS FROM WEB

1. Click the **DOWNLOAD**
2. A box will pop up, asking if you wish to save to **DISK**, select this even if the file is too large for a floppy because you will be saving it to your Hard Disk , the C: drive. We recommend, whenever possible to download to the A: drive onto a floppy disk, so you can do a virus scan before bringing it into your hard disk or opening it. However, you may choose to download to a folder on the C: drive directly and we suggest you create a folder and name it **ADOWNLOAD** as a subfolder to you're my **DOCUMENTS** folder.
This way, should you need to reinstall the program you've just downloaded, it will be there in the **ADOWNLOAD** folder.
3. Type the name of the download (your choice of name) in the **SAVE IN** (bottom box) and click **SAVE**.
4. If this is a file that must be installed, just locate the file either on the floppy disk or in the **ADOWNLOAD** folder and doubleclick it to start the install.
