Microsoft Internet Explorer Causes Invalid Page fault

When you type a Web address (URL) in the Internet Explorer Address box or you type a command in the Open box after clicking Run on the Start menu, you may receive one of the following error messages:

Explorer caused an invalid page fault in module Kernel32.dll Explorer caused an invalid page fault in module Shdocvw.dll Iexplore caused an invalid page fault in module Shdocvw.dll

This behavior can occur if an entry in the History folder has become damaged and the Internet Explorer AutoComplete feature cannot process it.

Disable the AutoComplete feature:

Right-click on the Internet Explorer icon and choose Properties, then click on the Advanced tab. Scroll down until you see "Use online Auto-Complete for Web addresses" and uncheck that box. Click OK.
