Script Error

Sometimes you may get this message, "An error has occurred in the script on this page."

This error message appears in Internet Explorer. It means that script (such as a Java script) in the page is not working properly.

Sometimes you may solve the problem simply by clicking the REFRESH button on the browsers menu bar. But in most cases Internet Explorer will continue to display the message until the web sites' Webmaster fixes the page.

If you'd like to continue using the part of the web page that functions correctly without triggering the error message, change the was Internet Explorer handles broken scripts.

Click Tools...Internet Options...Advanced tab and uncheck the boxes next to Disable Script Debugging. Also, make sure there is no check in the box next to Display A Notification About Every Script Error. Click Ok.

Note: later you will want to reverse the above checks so that you will receive the Script error messages.
