

Wireless Connection Fails

Wireless network does not find available networks and does not connect. It will connect if plugged with Ethernet cord, but not wirelessly.

1. Click START...Run, type in services.msc
2. Scroll down to wireless....click START and Automatic should be in the middle window.
3. Click Start...settings...network connections.
4. Rightclick the Dell (ctr) wireless Network Connections, select properties
5. Click center tab Wireless Network...
6. Put a check in the box, Use windows to configure
7. Click Apply and Ok
8. Now, click the single wireless icon in startup tray, select the available network you want to connect.
