Be Specific with your Search

- ♦ Check spelling (Google helps out and will provide you possible corrected spelling but this is not true for all engines)
 - Capitulation is important for names and products.
- ♦ Some engines require that you must case specific (exact upper and/or lower case).
- ♦ Do not generalize: "Fish Tanks" is a bad search; "Atlantic Marine or salt water fish tanks" is a far better search.

Key Symbols and Certain Text and very important

♦ "+" Connects words - A space is a default with some engines: Ohio State University is fine for some engines; otherwise use the plus signs, Ohio+State+University".

- ♦ "OR" means one or more of the words must appear in your answer. (e.g. Asthma, chronic or acute).
- ♦ "-" This excludes items from your answer as does "NOT (Some require AND NOT) which means this will not be in your answer.
- Using quotation marks " " where you want to include a phrase that must be used in its entirety for your search.

Great Search Engine with tutorials about searching the web

Here is Pandia's analogy of ordering a pizza with searching the web.

Lets say you want a pizza with pizza with pepperoni and ham, but with no olives and no garlic." Your search sentence would be

"pizza AND pepperoni AND ham AND NOT olives AND NOT garlic".

Now, lets assume you have a idea the pizzeria might be out of pepperoni where chicken could be a substitute, so enter

"pepperoni OR chicken' which uses the "OR" directive.

Lastly, you might want to tell the search engine that pan pizza is an expression or a phrase. For this you use double quotation marks: "...", like this:

"pan pizza" AND "Italian pepperoni" AND "black olives".





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Notice the words above the block for a search

Images – pictures and clip art on multiple subjects

Groups – Information and articles about many subjects

News – You can search for news articles by subject


When the Personalized Page opens, click on Personalize your home page
