Preparation

Existing PC

- Run a virus and spyware scan
- Run Disk cleanup
 - Start/All Programs/Accessories/System Tools/Disk Cleanup
- Determine the location of your data
- Organize your files and folders
- Make sure you have a current backup

New PC

- Remove all the trial software
- Install anti-virus and anti-spyware programs
- Install any Microsoft programs

Using Wizards

- XP and Vista come with an application called the File and Settings Transfer Wizard (FAST)
- To use it, connect the two PC together using a Cat5 crossover cable or connect both PC's to the port on a router
- You can also use an external drive
- Start the Wizard on both PC's and follow the directions

- Phone and modem options

- Screen saver selection
- Fonts
- Folder options

- Desktop folder
- My Documents folder
- My Pictures folder
- Favorites folder
- Cookies folder

Using External Media

Determine the amount of data to transfer

Floppy Disk1.44MB

- CD-ROM 650-700 MB

– DVD-ROM 4.7GB (Single layer)

8.5GB (Dual Layer)

USB Flash Drive Up to 8GB (Ready Boost)

External USB Up to 250GB

– Digital MediaUp to 4 GB

Using Your Old Hard Drive

- Install your old drive as a second drive in your new system
- Install your drive in an External USB drive Enclosure (\$25)

Transferring E-mail

- The FAST Wizard only recognizes Outlook and Outlook Express
- AOL
 - Open your Mail Box and click Manage Mail
 - Right click on Saved on My PC
 - Click Save As (Default file name is Email.pfc)
 - Save the file or E-mail it to yourself
- Others
 - Check the Help menu to find out how to Export your mail messages and address book.

Transferring Applications

- There are applications that will transfer your applications (most) to another PC
- I don't recommend any of them
- Do a clean install to prevent problems

Test Your new System

- Check ALL of your Data
- Run your all of your applications
- Hang on to your old system for awhile
