• Go to <u>www.aol.com</u>, obtain an AOL screen name (ID) and password. Now you are an AOL member and can use both the AOL Client Program or AOL webmail FREE.

• At the bottom of the <u>WWW.AOL.COM</u> page is an opportunity to download AOL full client version which you may install into your computer and use – FREE. While installing you'll be asked if you're a current member or a new member. Select Current Member and then enter the screen name and password setup above.

• You have the option to use the full AOL Client Program that you installed into your computer or to use the AOL webmail at <u>www.aol.com</u>.

• Installation of the AOL Client Program. Using FREE AOL means you will not have phone support to AOL. However, AOL provides all the information you will need within the AOL Client Program itself.

• AOL has great flexibility, is known for it's convenience and for being user friendly.

• It contains a browser (IE), very useful favorites, email organization, email graphics.

• AOL is like using IE (or firefox, Chrome), Outlook Express all in one. Can be a complete computer email with browsing application

• You may use Firefox, IE, Chrome as you have previously.

• Unlimited indefinite online email storage. May save email on AOL's server or on your computer or both.
