

**Flash Drive to Boost Memory**

***How to Add Memory to Your Computer, Without opening the Case (Works in Vista & Windows 7)!***

*For this to work you need a good quality Flash Drive, 4GB is a good size. If you are not sure which Flash Drive to buy, Lexar is usually good, but you can ask your retailer to direct you to a Flash Drive to be used for Memory Boost.*

- 1. First insert an empty flash drive that you plan to leave in the computer.***
- 2. Left click on Start***
- 3. Left click on Computer***
- 4. This should bring up a display showing all the drives connected to your computer.***
- 5. Find the Flash Drive and right-click on it, then choose Properties***
- 6. Select the "ReadyBoost Tab (already done in this illustration). The display will tell you if the Flash Drive is suitable for ReadyBoost or not. Assuming it is, Choose the memory allocation (e.g., 3.75 GB)***

***After setting the memory, choose Apply and close the procedure. Now, as long as you leave this Flash Drive connected, you will have the benefit of this added memory in your computer.***
