

Pinging

To ping a particular computer:

1. Click Start...Run and type in cmd (if using XP), type command if using Win98. Click OK
2. Black screen (msdos) opens. Type IPCONFIG/ALL press ENTER.
3. The IP addresses for all computers on your network that are on will be listed.
4. To ping one of the computers, type Ping (space) and type the IPaddress or name of a particular computer and press ENTER.
5. You will see a message of packets sent...packers received. IF none are received then your computer is not communicating with the other computer.
6. Check to make sure you've given the same Group Name to all the computers on your network and that each computer has a different Name and Description.
