What's new in Windows Vista Home Premium

Explore new features for searching, staying connected, networking, syncing devices, and managing files on your computer. Find things fast and focus on what matters to you.

Searching and organizing



In every folder in Windows, the Search box appears in the upper right corner. When you type in the Search box, Windows filters the view based on what you're typing. Windows looks for words in the file name, tags that you've applied to the file, or other file properties. To find a file in a folder, type any part of a file name in the Search box to find what you're looking for. You can also use **Search Folders** when you don't know where a file is located or when you want to do an advanced search using more than just a single file name or property.

Sync and sharing



Sync with other devices such as portable music players and Windows Mobile devices. With Sync Center, you can keep devices in sync, manage how your devices sync, start a manual sync, see the status of current sync activities, and check for conflicts. You can also share files and folders with people on your network, even if they use a computer that's not running Windows. When you share files and folders, other people can open and view the files and folders just as if they were stored on their own computer. And they can make changes, if you allow that.


