

Vista DVD Maker

Vista DVD Maker can convert those Windows XP Movie Maker files to DVD home movies which can be played on your TV's DVD player

- (1) In Vista Home Premium, click Start / Programs / Windows Programs / Windows DVD Maker.
- (2) When the program starts, click Add Items.
- (3) On the left hand side of the Program Window you will see the files in your computer. Locate the Win XP Movie Maker file and click once to highlight (select) it.
- (4) Click "Add" on the bottom of the Program Window.
- (5) Insert a blank DVD and click "Burn" on the bottom of the Program Window.

In a few minutes you will have a DVD movie, playable in any TV connected DVD player.

Note: It looks like this program can be used to burn a wide assortment of video and audio files, but not a Power Point File
