Question:

Is there any way to turn off vista's nagging way of requiring you to obtain permission regarding most everything you do without adversely affecting the operating system's performance.

Answer:

To turn off User Account Control (UAC), log in as the administrator. Go to the control panel and click Classic view and then double click User Accounts. Click "Turn User Account Control on or off" and then turn it off. Click OK.

This is really not a good idea because UAC is the security feature that prevents malware from changing your system settings.
