

RUN Dialog Box in Win 7

The RUN dialog box is a quick way to give your computer some system commands.

Press the Windows key + R to bring up the RUN dialog box.

Example 1:

Into the RUN dialog box type msconfig and press OK will take you to the MSCONFIG where you can click the STARTUP tab and see the programs which have been selected to run everyting you start your computer. Unchecking a box will prevent that program from starting every time you start your computer if you press APPLY after unchecking the box.

Example 2:

Type into the RUN box cmd.exe click ok brings up the C:\windows\system 32\cmd.exe window.
