

XP RECOVERY

There's no backup program that comes with the xp home edition. There's one included with the professional edition.

If the hard drive crashes then you need to call the manufacturer and have it replaced. The new drive will have the original software pre-loaded.

If the hard drive hasn't crashed and **you want to reload the system then turn on the pc and then hit the appropriate Function key to start the restore process.** Usually, the info about which key to hit appears at the bottom left of the screen when the pc is turned on.

Depending on the brand and purchase date of the PC, there may not be a recovery disk. There may be a recovery partition on the hard drive. If so then there will be an option to hit F10 or F11 on the PC logo screen when the PC is first turned on. This will start the restore program.
