To Turn off the Desktop Cleanup Wizard

- 1. Rightclick on a blank area of the desktop.
- 2. Click Properties, then click the Desktop tab.
- 3. Click Customize Desktop.
- 4. Remove the check in the box that says "Run Desktop Cleaner Wizard every 60 days".
- 5. If you wish to run the cleanup wizard manually, just click Run Wizard Now on that same screen.
