MS WORD 2003 Run Faster

If your WORD appears to be dragging, you can make some changes that may get more speed for you.

- 1. Open a document page in MSWORD.
- 2. Click Tools....Options.
- 3. The following are changes that you may want to try to speed up WORD.
 - a. Click VIEW tab and uncheck Animated Text box.
 - b. If you use Word in Normal View, then check Wrap to Window
 - c. Click GENERAL tab and uncheck Provide feedback with animation.
 - d. Increase or decrease the number of documents in the Recently Used Documents.
 - e. Under PRINT you might like to turn off the <u>Background printing</u> as most printers spool print jobs fast enough.

CAUTION: Make a note of each change in case the change made causes undesirable action in the way YOU like to use WORD.

WORD CALCULATOR

The WORD calculator is hidden. To revive it,

- 1. Select Tools...Customize.
- 2. Click the Command tab and then Tools in the Category list.
- 3. In right panel, locate the Tools Calculate button.
- 4. Click and Drag the Tools Calculate button up onto a Word toolbar.

Now, you may use its calculate function within a word document. Highlight numbers in your document and click the Tools Calculate Button on your Word toolbar. The results appear in the status bar in Word's lower left corner.
