

## iTunes Songs Stripped of DRM (from PC World Magazine)

Some apps strip out DRM that limit where you can play them, by cracking the encryption, but that is illegal. Achieve the same ends by the following:

1. Create a new playlist with all the songs you'd like to rip.
2. Use your software's Burn Disc option to copy the music to audio-CD format.
3. After you've burned the music to disc, rename the originally downloaded song to something like "My iTunes DRM".
4. Insert your newly burned CD-R and click Import CD to copy the songs back into iTunes or whichever player app you originally used. They will now be stripped of all DRM.
