MFC (Microsoft Foundation Class) is part of Microsoft's C++ application development language.

The MFC Application Wizard generates an application having built-in functionality that, when compiled, implements the basic features of a Windows executable (.exe) application.

If this is the case, you may need to reinstall the application or reinstall Microsoft net frameworks. To reinstall net frameworks, you can use add/remove programs in the control panel to remove it. Then go to the Microsoft windows update site (Start/All Programs/Windows update). The site should find that you no longer have net frameworks installed and download it for you.
